Frequently Asked Questions

Applicant Legal Status section:

There does not appear to be an option for a local incorporated association.

You need to be a member of QMTN to apply for these grants. Please use the “Other” option and specify Incorporated Association. The application form is one that GBRF use for a range of granting activities and so includes a variety of options.

Criteria 2:

Can we print educational material (including posters, flyers & magnets) as well as group shirts for our volunteers?

It is up to the Applicant to outline the outcomes, benefits and value for the requested equipment. All applications will be assessed on the criteria in the Guidelines.

Educational material printing is eligible, group shirts should be classified as sun smart PPE, (long sleeve and UV 50+ protection) to qualify.

Eligibility Criteria:

Could you please clarify whether these are insurances that applicants are required to already have, or whether this is simply a list of insurances that may be applicable to some projects?

Organisations are required to have the appropriate insurances for the types of work they plan to undertake. This will vary from group to group and project to project.

Eligibility Criteria:

Do WHS policies and procedures need to be in place already? What if one of our volunteers is currently preparing these?

Applicant organisations need to understand their legal requirements under WHS legislation. WHS policies and procedures would need to be finalised before any contracted granting can occur. GBRF will ask for evidence or documentation of this as part of due diligence, which follows assessment of all applications and determination of potential grantees. This will need to be in place by September 21 (a week after grants close).

How to Apply:

The Grant Guidelines make a reference to a sample agreement template. However, I could not locate this within the guidelines or application form.
